MOTION TO ORDER REPORTING

COMES NOW the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through undersigned counsel, and on behalf of himself and Respondent CMH Homes, Inc. (herein the “Parties”), for its *Motion to Order Reporting*, respectfully states as follows:

1. On September 29, 2015, the Commission issued its *Order Suspending Procedural Schedules, Consolidating Cases, And Setting Cases for Mediation*, wherein four separate actions between the Complainant and Respondent were consolidated and set for mediation on October 5.

2. On October, 5, 2015, the Complainant and Respondent discussed mutually agreeable terms to resolve all pending matters before the Commission. Those terms include:

- The Respondent commits to resolving all outstanding issues identified in the respective case files inspection reports within thirty (30) days. Where the Respondent is unable to complete the necessary repairs within the initial thirty (30) days, the Respondent will file a Status Report with the Commission detailing

the remaining work and be permitted one additional thirty (30) day extension to complete the necessary repairs.

- Upon the completion of repairs pertaining to each individual case file, the Respondent will notify the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Missouri Public Service Commission, who will make arrangements for a site inspection. Pursuant to the inspection report, the Director will withdraw a complaint if repairs have been made to address the issues identified in the respective case files complaints.
- The Respondent will provide additional contact information for representatives of CMH Homes, Inc., to ensure prompt response to notices issued by the Commission and timely submission of required reports in compliance with Commission rules.
- The Respondent agrees to make a payment of \$6,000 (USD) for the benefit of the Public School Fund, in a manner that has been communicated directly between the Parties, within thirty (30) days.

3. The Parties acknowledge that failure to comply the terms set forth in the agreement will result in the resumption of proceedings on the complaints.

4. As these terms are mutually agreed to by the Parties, the Parties request an Order directing the Respondent to file a Status Report by November 5, 2015.

WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully request issuance of an order to file a *Status Report* by November 5, 2015.
