**ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT
TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

Issue Date: March 17, 2022

Effective Date: April 16, 2022

This order approves an amendment to a negotiated Interconnection Agreement between the parties filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri.

On January 31, 2022, AT&T Missouri filed an application with the Commission for approval of an amendment to its negotiated Interconnection Agreement with Missouri Network Alliance, L.L.C. under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. AT&T Missouri is certificated with the Commission as an incumbent local exchange carrier. Missouri Network Alliance, L.L.C. is certificated with the Commission as a competitive local exchange and interexchange carrier.

Although Missouri Network Alliance, L.L.C. is a party to the Agreement, it did not join in the application. On February 8, 2022, the Commission issued an order making Missouri Network Alliance, L.L.C. a party in this case and directing any party wishing to request a hearing to do so no later than February 23, 2022. No requests for hearing were filed.

Under Section 252(e) of the Act, any Interconnection Agreement adopted by negotiation must be submitted to the Commission for approval. The Commission may

reject an Agreement if it finds that the Agreement is discriminatory or that it is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

On March 9, 2022, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation. Staff recommends that the Agreement as amended be approved and notes that the Agreement as amended meets the limited requirements of the Act in that it is not discriminatory toward nonparties and is not against the public interest.

The Commission has considered the application, the supporting documentation, and Staff's recommendation. Based upon that review, the Commission finds that the Agreement as amended meets the requirements of the Act in that it does not discriminate against a nonparty carrier and implementation of the Agreement as amended is not inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

The application represents that the applicant has not had contact with the office of the Commission about any substantive issue connected to the filing within 60 days before filing the application. On the basis of that representation, for good cause shown, the Commission will waive application of the pre-filing notice requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between AT&T Missouri and Missouri Network Alliance, L.L.C., filed on January 31, 2022, is approved.
2. This order shall become effective on April 16, 2022.
3. This file may be closed on April 17, 2022.




