
Please accept this letter as my request and as authorization to cancel Tariffs and Certificate of Service Authority.

Inacom ceased operation on June 16, 2000, when it filed for protection under Bankruptcy Law, Chapter 11, in the state of Delaware - Case #00-2426-PJW. I believe the Secretary of State dissolved the corporation in August 2000.

Inacom Corp et al. filed their Disclosure Statement pursuant to Section 1125 of the Bankruptcy Code with respect to the Joint Plan of Liquidation on March 25, 2003, in the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of Delaware. The Plan was voted on and confirmed in the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of Delaware at the May 22, 2003 hearing and became effective June 9, 2003.
