**MOTION TO OPEN CASE AND CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE  
AUTHORITY AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), and moves that the Commission open a case and cancel the certificate of service authority it has granted to Infonet Telecommunications Corporation to provide intrastate inter-exchange telecommunications services in Missouri, as well as non-switched local exchange telecommunications services limited to providing dedicated private line services, as well as its tariff. In support of its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

1. On June 8, 2002, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order granting a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri, as well as non-switched local exchange telecommunications services, limited to providing dedicated private line services, to Infonet Telecommunications Corporation in Case No. TA-2002-459, and approved its tariff, P.S.C. Mo. No. 1, in the same case.

2. Infonet Telecommunications Corporation, through a letter from its agent, has asked the Commission to cancel its certificate of service authority because it has no customers using the service that was to be provided under that name, and does not intend to pursue that line of business. See Appendix A. The agent is the corporation's assistant secretary is the same representative who prepared and filed the company's 2005 annual report at this Commission and its annual registration report with the Missouri Secretary of State's office.

3. Infonet Telecommunications Corporation owes no annual reports or assessments. No complaints have been submitted with respect to the company since the commencement of the Electronic Filing and Information System.

4. Because Infonet Telecommunications Corporation has requested cancellation of its certificate, and because it is not providing telecommunications service, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order canceling Infonet Telecommunications Corporation's certificate of service authority, as well as its tariff.

5. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2006), which provides:

“Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo.App. 1989).

6. This pleading is being served on the address provided by the company to the Commission via certified mail, as well as via regular mail upon its Missouri registered agent.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of Infonet Telecommunications Corporation to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services; to provide non-switched local exchange telecommunications services, limited to providing dedicated private line services; and also its tariff, P.S.C. Mo. No. 1.


Dear David:



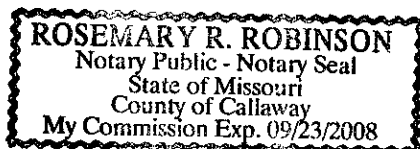


