JOINT RESPONSE TO ORDER DIRECTING FILING **OF CENTURYTEL OF MISSOURI, LLC AND** SPECTRA COMMUNICATIONS GROUP, LLC D/B/A CENTURYTEL

COME NOW CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC ("CenturyTel") and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel ("Spectra"), pursuant to the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Order Directing Filing And Making Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel A Party ("Order") entered in this matter on October 26, 2004, and for their Joint Response respectfully state as follows:

The Commission's Order directed the parties to explain (a) whether 47 1. U.S.C. § 252(e)(4) requires this Commission to act within 90 days of FullTel's petition, and (b) the relationship, if any, between CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel.

2. CenturyTel and Spectra respectfully concur in, and adopt by reference, the Staff Memorandum filed this date by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service The Staff addresses the two issues at Paragraphs 11 and 12 of its Commission. Memorandum. Staff notes that "According to Spectra's 2003 Annual Report to the Commission (BMAR-2004-0724), CenturyTel, Inc. owns 99.92104% of Spectra." (Staff Memorandum, pages 2-3). Spectra would point out that since the time of filing its 2003 Annual Report, CenturyTel, Inc. now owns 100% of Spectra.

3. As the Commission's records clearly reveal, CenturyTel and Spectra received separate certificates of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in Missouri, and provide such services in accordance with separate tariffs approved by this Commission.¹

4. The Staff Memorandum states at Paragraph 10: "By its Order in Case No. LA-2005-0055, effective October 29, 2004, the Commission granted FullTel certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service, nonswitched local exchange service, and interexchange service. Indeed, FullTel recognizes the separate certificates and tariffs of CenturyTel and Spectra in its own Application for Certificate of Service Authority filed on August 31, 2004 in Case No. LA-2005-0055:

With respect to the geographic coverage area for its basic local telecommunications services, FullTel requests authority to operate as a competitive basic local exchange carrier in all areas defined by the existing exchange areas in which SWBT, CenturyTel, Spectra Communications and Sprint are authorized to operate in Missouri. The SWBT, CenturyTel, Spectra Communications and Sprint exchanges in which Applicant seeks authority to provide basic local exchange services in Missouri are set forth in the tariffs of SWBT, CenturyTel, Spectra Communications and Sprint respectively. (Emphasis added).²

The Commission's Order in that proceeding granted FullTel its certificate of service authority in accordance with such request.
