AT&T MISSOURI'S APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO AN INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

AT&T Missouri, ¹ pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Act")² and 4 CSR 240-3.513(6)(C), respectfully submits this Application for Approval of an Amendment to an Interconnection Agreement by and between AT&T Missouri and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC ("MCImetro"), which amendment is entitled "Further Amendment to Amendment Superseding Certain Reciprocal Compensation, Interconnection and Trunking Terms." ("Further Amendment"). AT&T Missouri requests that the Commission approve the Further Amendment.

In support of this Application, AT&T Missouri states:

1. AT&T Missouri is a Missouri corporation with its principal Missouri office at One AT&T Center, Room 3520, St. Louis, Missouri 63101. It may be contacted at the regular and electronic mail addresses and telephone and facsimile numbers of its attorneys, as set out under the signature block of this Application. AT&T Missouri is authorized to do business in Missouri³ and its fictitious name is duly registered with the Missouri Secretary of State. AT&T Missouri is a "local exchange telecommunications company" and a "public utility," and is duly

authorized to provide "telecommunications service" within the State of Missouri, as each of those phrases is defined in Section 386.020, RSMo 2000.⁵

- 3. AT&T Missouri has no final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court, which involves retail customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.
- 4. AT&T Missouri does not have any annual report or assessment fees that are overdue in Missouri.
- 5. Pursuant to Section 252(e)(1) of the Act, AT&T Missouri seeks approval of the Further Amendment attached hereto, which has been signed by the parties. The Commission must approve the Further Amendment unless it determines that the Further Amendment (or any portion thereof) (1) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the amendment, or (2) the implementation of such amendment is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.⁶
- 6. AT&T Missouri states that the Further Amendment does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the Interconnection Amendment. AT&T Missouri

further states that the implementation of the Further Amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Further Amendment merely extends the term (through July 31, 2011) of the parties' earlier Amendment Superseding Certain Reciprocal Compensation, Interconnection and Trunking Terms, which the Commission approved on January 7, 2008, in Case No. TK-2008-0179.

WHEREFORE, AT&T Missouri respectfully requests that the Commission approve the attached amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between AT&T Missouri and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC.

- 1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Section 1 of the Amendment Superseding Certain Reciprocal Compensation Interconnection and Trunking Terms, the term of the Original Amendment will be extended and shall remain in effect through July 31, 2011. Thereafter, the Original Amendment will remain in full force and effect unless terminated in accordance with the terms thereof.
- 2. EXCEPT AS MODIFIED HEREIN, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE UNDERLYING AGREEMENT (INCLUDING ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO) SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
- 3. This Amendment shall be filed with and is subject to approval by the applicable state Commissions.
