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

NOTICE OF DISMISSAL AND CLOSING OF CASE

This notice notices the dismissal of the case and closes it.


On June 14, 2001, the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles, and Modular Units of the Missouri Public Service Commission and Rightway Homes filed their joint motion to dismiss a complaint. Attached to the motion was a certificate of service, showing that it had been served on all parties, and a Settlement Agreement and Release, discharging all claims against Rightway.

The parties cited Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116, which covers the notice of the dismissal of a case and states:

an applicant...may voluntarily dismiss an application...without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties.

No testimony has been filed, no oral evidence been offered, and a copy of the notice was served on all parties. The Missouri Public Service Commission will take notice of the dismissal of this case and will close the same.
