On December 4, 2009, Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede" or "Company") submitted to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") revised tariff sheets reflecting increased rates for gas service provided to customers in its Missouri service area. The proposed tariff sheets contained a requested effective date of January 4, 2010, and were designed to produce a net annual incremental increase of approximately \$52.6 million in permanent rates charged for gas service, exclusive of amounts that were then being collected by the Company through its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS"). In addition to the proposed tariff sheets, the Company also submitted its minimum filing requirements and prepared direct testimony in support of its requested rate increase.

By Order dated December 10, 2009, the Commission suspended the proposed tariff sheets and established a procedural schedule for interventions and evidentiary hearings. By subsequent orders, the Commission granted the applications to intervene filed by the Missouri Energy Group (Barnes-Jewish Hospital and SSM HealthCare) ("MEG"); Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (Anheuser-Busch Companies Inc., The Boeing Company, Hussmann Refrigeration, J.W. Aluminum, Monsanto Company, Proctor & Gamble, and U.S. Silica) ("MIEC"); USW Local 11-6 ("Union"), and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources ("MDNR").
