TO FILE STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On December 5, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a request for an extension of time to file its recommendation concerning the application of Bandwidth.com CLEC, LLC. In support of its motion Staff advised the Commission that it had requested additional information from Bandwidth that it needed to fairly evaluate the application, and that Bandwidth was actively collecting that information. To allow Staff sufficient time to acquire and review the information and then produce its recommendation, Staff asks the Commission to give it an additional ten days to file its recommendation, or until December 20, 2007. The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its recommendation on or before December 20, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on December 6, 2007.
