**ORDER EXTENDING TIME**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting in part the motion for extension of time (“motion”) that the Commission’s staff (“Staff”) filed on January 4, 2010. Staff asks the Commission to extend the time for filing Staff’s recommendation indefinitely, subject to monthly reporting, because the application remains incomplete. An incomplete application is grounds for denial, but Staff suggests that an extension of time will allow completion of the application. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion in part as follows.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than February 4, 2010, the Commission’s staff shall file either its recommendation as to the application or a report as to the status of the application.
2. This order is effective immediately upon issuance.
