- SUBJECT: Staff Recommendation in the Matter of Atmos Energy Corporation's Motion for Waiver of Tariff Provisions Related to the Filing of a Revised ACA and Motion for Expedited Treatment
- DATE: September 24, 2009

On September 15, 2009, Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos or Company), of Franklin, Tennessee, filed a Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) tariff sheet with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) with a proposed effective date of October 1, 2009. In addition, Atmos filed a Motion for Waiver of Tariff Provisions and Motion for Expedited Treatment (Motion) to the filing of a revised Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) Factor. On September 16, 2009, the Commission issued an ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE ECOMMENDATION AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR RESPONSE (ORDER) for Staff to file its recommendation no later than September 25, 2009. This memorandum is in response to that ORDER.

Atmos seeks a Waiver from its PGA tariff provisions to file revised ACA factors for its SEMO, NEMO and Rich Hill/Hume (Greeley or West Area) Districts. Atmos' ACA levels for its SEMO and NEMO Districts will be nearly \$0 by the end of September 2009. By making these changes now, Atmos will have *de minimus* ACA balances and avoid an over-collection of these costs for the upcoming regular ACA filing in November 2009. The Commission's Energy Tariff/Rate Design Staff (Staff) has reviewed SEMO and NEMO's ACA balances and is of the opinion these changes should be made. This change will eliminate the separate ACA balances of the SEMO and Neelyville Districts and will complete the consolidation of the SEMO PGA district pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. GR-2006-0387.

In Atmos' Greeley District, the Company will not be able to refund all of the ACA balance before the winter PGA/ACA filing. Atmos is proposing a one-time refund to its Greeley customers in order to zero out the unconsolidated Greeley District ACA balance. This balance reflects Greeley's ACA balance prior to its consolidation with the Butler District. The amount of the refund will be approximately \$10.56 per customer. This change will eliminate the separate ACA balances and complete the consolidation of the West PGA district.

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Staff has reviewed the Company's tariff filing and has determined that the tariff sheet has been filed in compliance with Atmos' PGA Clause, Commission rules and regulations. Staff is of the opinion that good cause for approval of these tariff sheets on less than thirty (30) days notice is demonstrated by Atmos' Commission-approved PGA clause allowing for ten (10) business days notice for PGA change filings and its Motion. Staff has no objection to Atmos' request because the SEMO and NEMO's District's ACA balances are nearing zero by end of September 2009, thereby avoiding an over-collection of gas costs. Staff also has no objection to Atmos' request for a one time credit to customers in the old Greeley District, because the one time credit will complete the consolidation of the old Greeley and Butler PGA Districts. Staff has reviewed this filing and is not aware of any issue currently pending before the Commission that affects, or is affected by, this filing.

The consolidation of PGA districts was authorized by the Commission in Atmos' last rate case, GR-2006-0387. That issue was not taken up on appeal.

Therefore, Staff recommends that the following tariff sheet and Motion be approved, as filed on September 15, 2009, and be allowed to become effective on October 1, 2009.
