MOTION TO CONTINUE FILING DATE

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE) and for its Motion to Continue Filing Date, states as follows:

- 1. On December 5, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an Order Adopting Procedural Schedule.
- 2. On December 12, 2007, the Commission issued its Order Suspending AmerenUE's Obligation to File Direct Testimony. The Order required AmerenUE to file the revised tariff or testimony no later than January 11, 2008.
- 3. On January 11, 2008, AmerenUE filed a motion asking for an extension of the suspension date until January 18, 2008. The request was granted by the Commission.
- 4. As previously stated, the parties in this docket are working on language for an agreed upon IDR tariff and for a Stipulation and Agreement. However, as these documents have been developed, disagreements on a few, discrete issues have developed and remain unresolved. AmerenUE anticipates working through these issues next week and hopes it will have agreed upon language by January 25, 2008. If it is unable to reach agreement on all aspects of this tariff, the parties plan to make a joint filing containing both the agreed upon issues as well as setting forth the issues left for Commission resolution. AmerenUE believes, at most, that there will only be a few issues that the

Commission will need to address. The majority of issues with the tariff have been agreed to among the parties.

5. The attorneys for the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel and the Missouri Energy Group have indicated that they have no objection to this Motion.

WHEREFORE, for the above stated reasons, AmerenUE asks that the Commission order that it file the revised IDR tariff and Stipulation and Agreement or pleading setting for resolved and unresolved issues by January 25, 2008.
