**REPLY TO MSBA'S RESPONSE REGARDING THE MSBA
PILOT PROGRAM REPORT**

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri” or “Company”) and briefly replies to the Missouri School Board Association's ("MSBA") May 1, 2020 Response to the MSBA Pilot Program Report. On April 30, 2020, pursuant to paragraph 5 of the *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement as to MSBA Issues* (“Stipulation”) filed July 23, 2019 in the above-captioned matter, the Company submitted the confidential MSBA Pilot Program Report ("Report"). The Report provided data tracked pursuant to the agreed upon Tracking Plan filed on September 30, 2019. The Report did not make any assertions regarding the data tracked. MSBA's May 1, 2020 Response to the Report makes assertions regarding the data presented in the Report. There is no procedural mechanism contemplated for the Company to clarify or address MSBA's assertions in this docket. Therefore, the Company merely hereby confirms that it plans to, and reserves all rights to, address the data tracked and presented in the Report in the appropriate future docket — in the Company's next natural gas general rate case.
