- The Applicant is a Missouri corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri. Its principal office and place of business is 27 Southern Drive, Columbia, Boone County, Missouri. The Applicant is a public utility as defined in §386.020 RSMo. 1969. The Applicant proposes to render sewer services to the public under jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission. A copy of the Certificate of Incorporation and Articles of Incorporation are attached to this Application as Exhibit 1.
- 2. - The Applicant requests permission, approval and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area in Boone County, Missouri as set forth on the map attached to this application. as Exhibit 2 and legally described by metes and bounds on the



exhibit ctached hereto and marked Exhibit 3.

4. The Applicant has completed a feasibility study and the same is attached to this Application and made a part hereof as Exhibit 4.

5. There are no municipalities located within the proposed areas and the Applicant is not required by the Boone County Court to obtain a franchise to operate in the County.

6. Said sewer system meets all requirements of the Commission and Department of Natural Resources. A copy of the construction permit which was issued by the Department of Natural Resources is attached hereto and made a part of this Application and numbered Exhibit 6.

7. There are no public utilities or other governmental bodies being operated or rendering sewer service within the area proposed to be served.

8. The area the Applicant requests permission to serve is rapidly being developed into a subdivision by the developer and plans are being made to build residential homes within this area. Adequate sewer service is required. Therefore, a public need exists for adequate sewer service within the area proposed to be served and the public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting of the authority herein requested.

9. Names and addresses of ten residents of the proposed service area who are also owners of the land are attached hereto and marked Exhibit 7.

WHEREFORE, the applicant requests the Commission to grant it permission, approval and a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity which will authorize it to install, acquire, build, construct, own and operate as well as control, manage and maintain a sewer system for the public within the area referred to above, and for such other orders as the Commission shall deem fitting and proper, including the setting of rate charges.






