NOW COMES Now Acquisition Corporation ("NAC" or "Applicant"), by and through

its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Sections 392.361, 392.410, 392.420, 392.430,

392.440 RSMo, and 4 CSR 240-2.060(6) and 4 CSR 240-3, files this verified Application

requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission (hereinafter "the Commission")

issue an order that:

1.

- (a) grants Applicant a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate resold, interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services, as herein more specifically defined, pursuant to Chapter 392 RSMo;
- (b) grants competitive status to Applicant and Applicant's requested services;
- (c) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Sections 392.420 and 392.361 RSMo, consistent with the Commission's past treatment of other certificated providers of competitive interexchange/dedicated private line telecommunications services; and
- (d) approves Applicant's proposed tariffs.

Applicant seeks expedited treatment of this Application and the proposed tariff filed

separately this date, as well as two related applications and a related tariff. A Motion for

Expedited Treatment is being filed simultaneously herewith seeking approval no later than

September 23, 2003. Similar motions for expedited treatment have been filed in the related cases. In support of its requests herein, Applicant states that:

1. Now Acquisition Corporation is a foreign corporation formed and operating under the laws of the State of Delaware and is duly authorized to transact business in the State of Missouri. The character of the business performed by Applicant is telecommunications. The Applicant's Certificate of Authority to do business in Missouri from the Missouri Secretary of State's Office is attached to this Application as *Appendix A-1*. Applicant's principal place of business is 6590 West Rogers Circle, Suite 6A, Boca Raton, FL 33487.

3. By this Application, Applicant proposes to provide various types of intrastate interexchange and non-switched private line telecommunications services throughout the state of Missouri on a resold basis. At this time Applicant is seeking authority to provide non-switched, dedicated private line services. Specifically, Applicant seeks authority to provide a full range of "1+" interexchange services, MTS, out-WATS, in-WATS, and Calling Card Services, and where appropriate, non-switched local exchange/private line services. Applicant provides telecommunications services to residential and business customers. Applicant combines high quality transmission services with very competitive rates, flexible end user billing, professional customer service and excellent reporting to create a unique blend that meets individualized needs of such customers. Applicant intends to engage in "switchless resale." Applicant will arrange for the traffic of underlying subscribers to be routed directly over the networks of Applicant's network providers.

4. Pursuant to 4 CSR 4 CSR 240-3.510(1), which requires that an application for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange, local exchange or basic local exchange service shall include a proposed tariff with no less than a forty-five (45) day effective date, Applicant is separately filing its proposed interexchange (IXC) tariff, designated as Mo. P.S.C. Tariff No. 1. Applicant's proposed IXC tariff contains the rules, conditions and description of services and rates, and bears an effective date of September 23, 2003, more than the required forty-five (45) days. Applicant respectfully requests

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approval of its IXC tariff, Mo. P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1.

5. Pursuant to this Application, Applicant also seeks classification of itself and its new interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications service offerings as competitive, with accompanying reduced regulation pursuant to Sections 392.361 RSMo and 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(A). Applicant believes that its proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation and that granting this request will allow greater price and service options for telephone users.

6. Applicant is willing to comply with all applicable Commission orders, rules and regulations. Applicant requests however, pursuant to Section 392.440 RSMO, that the Commission at minimum waive the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as they relate to the regulation of Applicant to the extent that they previously and routinely have been waived for other certificated competitive interexchange/private line carriers:

7. Applicant is financially capable of providing the services proposed. Applicant also possesses the necessary technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes to offer at standards that will meet or exceed all service standards established by the Commission.

8. Applicant states that it does not have any pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action judgment or decision has occurred with three (3) years of the date of this Application.

9. Applicant states that no Commission annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission: (1) expeditiously grant it a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate, resold interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Missouri; (2) grant Applicant and its proposed services competitive status; (3) waive the application of the above-referenced statutes and Commission rules, consistent with past Commission practice and the Commission's treatment of other certificated, competitive providers of intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services; and (4) approve its proposed tariffs submitted herewith.
