## MISSOURI GAS ENERGY'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Come now Missouri Gas Energy ("MGE"), a division of Southern Union Company, by and through counsel, and for this motion for extension of time respectfully state as follows:

- 1. On August 28, 2002, the Staff filed a "Gas Incident Report" ("the Incident Report") in Case No. GS-2002-345. Also on August 28, 2002 the Staff filed a "Complaint" against MGE alleging violation of certain Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") rules. The Complaint and the Incident Report involve the same incident.
- 2. By "Notice" dated September 16, 2002, in Case No. GS-2002-345, MGE was advised that its response to the Incident Report is due no later than October 28, 2002. By a "Notice of Complaint" dated September 4, 2002, in Case No. GC-2003-0076, MGE was advised that it was to file an Answer or the measures taken to satisfy the Complaint on or before October 4, 2002.
- 3. MGE has been engaged in discussions with the Staff regarding both the Complaint and the Incident Report. MGE believes that it is close to reaching an agreement with the Staff that would resolve the matters raised by the Staff in both the Complaint and the Incident Report. However, MGE does not believe it will be able to finalize the agreement by October 4, 2002 (the deadline for filing an Answer or the measures taken to satisfy the Complaint). MGE

believes time would be more productively spent working on an agreement instead of an Answer. Therefore, MGE respectfully requests an extension of time, until October 28, 2002, to file an Answer or the measures taken to satisfy the Complaint. Granting this extension of time should not prejudice any party's interests.

4. Counsel for the Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel have been apprised of the contents of this pleading and have expressed no objection.

WHEREFORE, MGE respectfully request that the Commission grant it an extension of time, until October 28, 2002, to file an Answer or the measures taken to satisfy the Complaint.
