This table details how many Large General Service (LGS) customers would be able to take advantage of a lower usage threshold to become a new class of Transportation customers. Currently, to be an LGS customer, usage must be greater than 10,000 CCF in any one year and less than 30,000 CCF in any one month. An exception is made for those customers who use more than 30,000 CCF in any one month to stay in the LGS class with request from customer and approval from MGE. Based on usage for the year 2009, the LGS class has 3,197 customers. Of those customers, 628 (20%), would meet a usage threshold of greater than 30,000 CCF in any one year.
