Dear Secretary,

I previously wrote to ask that MGE be required to lower the usage requirement for customers choosing to receive transportation service on the MGE system. I understand this is now being proposed by MGE, however, MGE wants to require all new transportation customers to have a measurement equipment installed at the customers expense to measure usage on a daily basis. I am not a utility expert but I know that customers on the Kansas Gas Service system just across the river in Kansas are not required to have this equipment installed to receive transportation service.

I am an owner of a laundry as well as the President of the Misouri-Kansas Laundry Assn. It doesn't make sense to me or members of our association that those located on the Kansas side of the river do not have to have this equipment installed and incur the cost of several thousand dollars while those in Missouri would have to. It sounds like it is just a barrier to discourage customers like members of our association operating in Missouri to not have the choices that they would if they were operating in Kansas.

I am asking that potential transportation customers in Missouri be given the same opportunities as those in the State of Kansas.
