**ORDER CLOSING CASE**

On November 7, 2008, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Close Case. Staff explained that the 2008 General Assembly amended the relevant statute, Section 392.245.11 RSMo, with H.B. 1779. With this statutory change, Staff stated that this case had become moot.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.36.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. The only response was on November 10, 2008, from Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri. AT&T Missouri agreed with Staff's analysis that H.B. 1779 makes this case moot, and stated that it did not oppose Staff's motion.

The Commission will take up Staff's motion unopposed. The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Motion to Close Case filed by the Staff of the Commission on November 7, 2008 is granted.
2. This case shall be closed on November 18, 2008.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
