MOTION FOR A CONTINUANCE

Comes the Turkey Mountain Homeowners Association, by their attorneys of record, FAIN & FAIN, 333 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101 and makes its Application and Motion For A Continuance based upon the following facts:

- 1. Ozark Mountain Water Company, in its application filed February 2, 1978 did not file certain exhibits which normally would be filed with an application, all of such exhibits being listed in paragraph 15 of its Application For A Certificate.
- 2. It proposes that it will file such exhibits at the time of the hearing. However, these intervenors are in need of such exhibits in order to prepare properly for cross-examination and for presentation in opposition to the certificate. There is no way that these intervenors can prepare for proper cross-examination without a copy of a proforma balance sheet and operating statement for proper study before the hearing. In order for the intervenors to properly prepare for the hearing, it will be necessary that they have such documents and be able to study same in regard to the certificated area being sought and also in regard to the costs that have already been expended. This cannot be determined without a study of the exhibits which have not been entered.

Wherefore, intervenors ask that the Commission require that the applicant to file its copies of its exhibits, and that a copy of same be furnished to the attorneys of the intervenors and that this matter be continued until there has been sufficient time to prepare for cross-examination.
