2 JUDGE STEARLEY: Today is December 5th,
3 2006, and we are here for a prehearing conference in the
4 matter of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, LP, doing
5 business as AT&T Missouri's revision to its general tariff
6 exchange -- general exchange tariff PSC Missouri No. 35
7 regarding provision of 811 service. It's Case No.
8 IT-2007-0187, Tariff No. JI-2007-0260.

9 My name is Harold Stearley. I'm the
10 presiding officer in this matter. Our court reporter this
11 morning is Kellene Feddersen. And we will begin by taking
12 entries of appearance, beginning with AT&T Missouri.

13 MR. GRYZMALA: Good morning, your Honor,
14 and thank you for the conference call opportunity. This
15 is Robert Gryzmala, attorney, representing Southwestern
16 Bell Telephone, LP, d/b/a AT&T Missouri. I am at One AT&T
17 Center, Room 3516, St. Louis, Missouri 63101.

18 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Gryzmala.
19 And Missouri One Call System?

20 MR. COMLEY: Thank you, Judge. Let the
21 record reflect the entry of Mark W. Comley, Newman,
22 Comley & Ruth, 601 Monroe Street, Suite 301,
23 Jefferson City, Missouri 65101, on behalf of Missouri One
24 Call System, Inc.

25 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Comley.

1 Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission?

2 MR. MEYER: Good morning. David Meyer on
3 behalf of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service
4 Commission. Our address is P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City,
5 Missouri 65102.

6 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Meyer.
7 Mr. Dandino from the Office of Public Counsel had called
8 in and is unable to be here today, but he said he would be
9 getting with the parties later.

10 I don't believe we have any preliminary
11 matters or motions or anything to address. I know we're
12 on kind of an expedited hearing schedule. Are there any
13 problems with sticking to our schedule here? Parties
14 having any problems getting their case together?

15 MR. COMLEY: None that I can identify now.

16 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. And I've asked
17 for a procedural schedule to be submitted by December
18 13th, so -- actually, excuse me. I believe I've already
19 set the matter, didn't I?

20 MR. COMLEY: Yes, you did.

21 JUDGE STEARLEY: Because we were on an
22 expedited schedule.

23 MR. GRYZMALA: We have issues list,
24 et cetera due Friday, I believe.

25 JUDGE STEARLEY: That's right. That's

1 right. Pardon me. I was looking at the wrong item here.

2 MR. GRYZMALA: Yeah.

3 MR. COMLEY: I've got down issues list
4 December 8th, positions statement on the 15th and hearing
5 scheduled for the 21st.

6 MR. STEARLEY: 21st, right.

7 MR. GRYZMALA: We have the Sunshine request
8 matter of, Mark, separate folks. I'm showing that on
9 10 a.m., the 13th. That's a different matter.

10 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay.

11 MR. GRYZMALA: Okay. And in joining with
12 Mr. Comley, I don't see any reason at this time why the
13 procedural schedule that was adopted can't be adhered to
14 by us.

15 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Well ,very
16 good. Sorry to have confused matters there for a moment.
17 Looking at too many things on my plate.

18 If there's nothing more for me to address
19 this morning, we'll end the record portion of this and
20 I'll leave the parties to their discussions.
