
AG PROCESSING INC, RESPONSE TO REQUEST

Intervenor Ag Processing Inc, a Cooperative (AGP) responds to the Commission's Order Directing Response regarding the status of settlement discussions as follows: The issues at a fundamental level are the size of the increase and, if the QCA is to be continued, should any modifications to its existing terms be permitted. Although there have been discussions of these issues among the parties and proposals have been exchanged, to date there have been no resolution of any of these issues. Discussions are again scheduled for tomorrow, April 29, but the

outcome of those discussions and any discussions thereafter are presently unknown.


