MOTION TO EXTEND COMMENT PERIOD  
OF AG PROCESSING INC A COOPERATIVE

The Commission, by Order, established May 30, 2014 as the time to receive comments on this filing. At the scheduling conference on May 19, 2014 Counsel for AGP inquired of the parties represented whether there would be support or opposition to a request to extend this period by ten days to June 9, 2014. No party that was represented indicated that they would oppose, and some indicated that they would support such a request.

AGP now MOVES that the Commission extend the period of time within which comments on this filing may be received by ten days or until May 9, 2014. Although no party present indicated opposition, not all parties were represented. Hence representation of unanimity cannot be made. Moreover, the status of parties to this proceeding as a non-contested proceeding and is unclear. For these reasons no representation beyond that made herein can be provided.

The additional time is needed to make further analysis of the filing and to obtain additional information from the applicant regarding the filing.

WHEREFORE AGP respectfully MOVES that the period of time within which comments on this filing may be received be extended by ten days to June 9, 2014.
