STAFF AND OPC’S LIST OF ISSUES FOR DETERMINATION

Staff and OPC propose the following list of issues:

1. Can Suburban provide safe and adequate water service to its customers today and in the future with the standpipe in its current condition?
 - (a) If the Commission determines Suburban cannot provide safe and adequate water service with the standpipe in its current condition, then what reasonable improvement(s) should the Commission order to resolve this issue?
2. Is the integrity of Suburban’s water system sufficient to maintain a minimum water pressure of 20 psi and provide safe and adequate water service to Suburban’s customers?
 - (a) If the Commission determines the integrity of Suburban’s water system is insufficient to maintain a minimum water pressure of 20 psi or

otherwise cannot provide safe and adequate water service, then what should the Commission order to resolve this issue?

3. Should Gordon Burnam be held personally liable for the obligations of Suburban Water Company because he owns, operates, controls and manages Suburban without regard to Suburban's corporate status.
