## **ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING REQUESTS TO INTERVENE, AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING RECOMMENDATIONS**

This order directs that notice of this case be sent to all certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications companies in the state of Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator. The order also establishes dates for the filing of requests to intervene, for the filing of recommendations, and granting the motion for expedited treatment.

On December 18, 2007, Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC filed an under 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv), requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Pooling Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc., to withhold certain numbering resources from Charter. The numbering resources Charter requested consist of a ten thousand (10,000) number block in the Wentzville rate center, which will be designated as Metropolitan Calling Area (MCA)-

related. The MCA numbering resources are required in order to offer and support local telecommunications services in the Wentzville rate center.

The Commission concludes that good cause has been shown pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16). The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed to file a request for intervention or a motion for hearing. Therefore, the Commission will set a time for interventions as directed below. The Commission will also direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri. In addition, the Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.

The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation and will establish a date by which any other party wishing to respond must file a recommendation.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.
2. Any party wishing to intervene or to request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than January 8, 2008, with:

4. Any other party that wishes to file a recommendation regarding the application of Charter shall do so no later than January 8, 2008, and shall file its recommendation simultaneously with its application to intervene.

5. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding the application of Charter, no later than January 18, 2007.

6. This order shall become effective December 19, 2007.
