On December 31, 2007, Comcast IP Phone of Missouri, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Voice filed an application for Approval of a Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Local Exchange and Interchange Telecommunications Services and for Competitive Classification.

On August 28, 2008, HB 1779 became law. Under Chapter 392.550.3 of the new law, VoIP providers must obtain a registration from the Missouri Public Service Commission. Pursuant to §392.550 RSMo 2008 (Cum. Supp.), Comcast filed an application for registration to offer and provide interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol and received its registration on September 17, 2008. On October 29, Comcast filed a withdrawal of its December 31, 2007 Application as there was no longer a need for Comcast to receive the certificate of service authority for local and interexchange telecommunications services.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Application of Comcast IP Phone of Missouri, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Voice for Approval of a Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Local Exchange and Interchange Telecommunications Services and for Competitive Classification is withdrawn.

 - 3. This case shall be closed.
