**JOINTLY PROPOSED PROCEDURAL  
SCHEDULE**

COME NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Company or Ameren Missouri), the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC), and the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy (DE), being all the parties to this case, and hereby submit this Jointly Proposed Procedural Schedule, and in support thereof state as follows:

1.        The named parties to this case have reached agreement on a proposed procedural schedule to determine what level of performance incentive has been earned by Ameren Missouri for the three program years of its MEEIA Cycle 1 (2013-2015) demand-side management plan, which was approved in this case. The parties request that the Commission adopt the procedural schedule set forth in paragraph 2 below.

2.        The Proposed Procedural Schedule is as follows:

3. Kansas City Power & Light (KCPL) is not a signatory to this pleading but counsel for KCPL has authorized Ameren Missouri to indicate that they do not oppose the schedule set forth above.

4. Ameren Missouri requests to have a Missouri Public Service Commission order by November 23, 2016, so that the awarded performance incentive may be included in the Ameren Missouri's annual Energy Efficiency Investment Charge tariff filing it intends to file in November.

WHEREFORE, the parties file the Jointly Proposed Procedural Schedule set forth in paragraph 2 above, and request that the Commission adopt the same.
