

REQUEST FOR DELAY IN ISSUANCE OF ORDER


COMES NOW the City of Springfield, Missouri, and requests that this Commission not issue its Order for a Video Authorization to provide video service within the limits of Springfield, Missouri for MMC Missouri LLC (hereinafter "Company") until March 7, 2008, thirty days after the filing of the Notice of Change of Application, for the following reasons:

1. The Company has abandoned the refranchising process under federal law.
2. The City of Springfield had in place, prior to the effective date of SB 284, a master video franchise ordinance that, in the absence of a statewide authorization, would control the provision of video service with the limits of Springfield, Missouri.
3. The City did not receive notice of this Notice of Change of Application, but discovered it by accident while searching the Commission's website on another matter just days ago.
4. That the City requires the full remaining thirty (30) days notice to consider its options under federal and state law with respect to response, if any, to the Company's notice.

5. That the Commission is not obligated to issue any order until thirty (30) days has passed after the filing of the Notice of Change, under Section 67.2679.7, RSMo Supp 2007, which would not be any earlier than March 7, 2008.
6. That the Company's current franchise with the City of Springfield does not expire before the end of such thirty (30) days and therefore delay in issuing the order as requested herein in no way prejudices the Company's rights if any.

WHEREFORE, the City of Springfield, Missouri requests that the Commission not issue an order authorizing the Company to provide video service within the City of Springfield, Missouri before March 7, 2008.


