MOTION TO SUBMIT CASE ON VERIFIED APPLICATION AND ATTACHMENTS

COMES NOW the Applicant in the above captioned matter and moves the Commission to take up and consider the Application herein, as amended, for consideration and approval by the Commission based on the Verified Application, Amended Application, and Attachment thereto filed herein.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On September 17, 1996, Osage Water Company filed an application with the Commission requesting an Order from the Commission granting certificates of convenience and necessity to provide sewer and water service to an unincorporated area of Camden County, Missouri known as "Cimmarron Bay," and sewer service to an area, also a part of Camden County, known as "Chelsea Rose." Plans, a feasibility study, a plat map, proposed water tariff pages adding the new water service areas, and a proposed sewer tariff were filed as attachments to the original Application. On September 20, 1996, the Commission issued its Order and Notice herein directing that Notice of the Application be made to the general public and interested parties, and directing that Applications to Intervene be filed no later than the close of business on October 21, 1996. No Applications to Intervene were filed in this case. On May 21, 1997, the Applicant filed an Amendment to the Application attaching thereto a revised proposed Sewer Tariff.

ARGUMENT IN SUPPORT OF MOTION

Over one year has now elapsed since the filing of the Application herein. The Applicant has engaged in extensive discussions with Staff concerning the proposed Sewer Tariff, and has amended the proposed Tariff as requested by Staff. The revised tariff has been on file with the Commission since May 21, 1997. There are no Intervenors, and this case is ready for submission to the Commission based on the Application, as amended, and the attachments thereto.

WHEREFORE, Osage Water Company prays that the Commission take up and consider its Application herein, as amended, upon the Verified Application and Attachments thereto, and upon such consideration, for an Order of this Commission granting Applicant a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide sewer service to Cimmarron Bay and Chelsea Rose, and a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide water service to Cimmarron Bay as prayed for in the Application.
