OPPOSITION OF SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY TO MOTION TO RECONSIDER APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF SHOW ME COMPETITION, INC.

COMES NOW Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and for its response to the Motion to Reconsider Application to Intervene of Show Me Competition, Inc. (Show Me) respectfully states as follows:

- 1. Show Me filed its initial Application to Intervene on December 21, 1998.

 Appendix A listed seven purported members of Show Me: (1) Citizen Action, (2)

 CompTel Missouri, (3) Telecommunications Resellers Association, (4) Mo

 Telecommunications Coalition, c/o AT&T, (5) Mo Cable Telecommunications

 Association, (6) City Utilities of Springfield, and (7) McLeod USA.
- 2. SWBT filed its opposition to Show Me's Application to Intervene on December 29, 1998. SWBT's opposition explained that Show Me was a front group for entities which were otherwise already participating in this docket, and that granting intervention would allow these entities to have "two bites at the apple." It would allow these entities to give two opening statements, engage in two cross-examinations of each witness, and engage in unilateral discovery, while claiming to be insulated from discovery on the basis that they had no information independent of their members.

SWBT pointed out that six of the seven purported members of Show Me appeared to already be participants in this case.

- 3. In its Order of December 30, 1998, the Commission rejected the application of Show Me on the basis that "it is not in substantial compliance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) because it does not clearly define what interest Show Me has that is different than the interest of the general public or from that of entities which have already been made parties to the case." December 30, 1998 Order at p. 6. The Commission did permit Show Me the opportunity to clarify the identity of its members and to state which of the entities have an interest in the matter which is not already represented.
- 4. The Motion to Reconsider filed by Show Me does not resolve the concerns previously expressed by SWBT. The majority of the purported members of Show Me are already represented in this docket. It is SWBT's understanding that Show Me is primarily funded by AT&T and other interexchange carriers and does not have an interest different than those of its members who are already participating in this case.
 - A. The Motion to Reconsider makes no attempt to justify intervention on the basis of membership by the Telecommunications Resellers

 Association (TRA), Mo Telecommunications Coalition c/o AT&T (MTC), Missouri Cable Telecommunications Association

 (MCTA), City Utilities of Springfield or McLeod USA. These are five of the seven purported members of Show Me listed in

 Appendix A to the December 21, 1998 Application to Intervene.

 City Utilities and McLeod are already participants in this docket.

 (See: December 9, 1998 Order Granting Interventions, p. 11,

ORDERED 2, Attachment A at p. 5 and December 30, 1998 Order Granting Interventions and Modifying Procedural Schedule, p. 10, ORDERED 2.) TRA and MCTA are independently seeking to participate in this docket. If the Commission allows participation directly by these entities, dual participation through Show-Me is inappropriate; if the Commission denies participation to these entities directly, they should not be permitted to evade the Commission's decision and participate indirectly through Show Me.

Since a majority of the purported members of Show Me identified in its initial filing are already seeking to participate in this docket, it would be wholly inappropriate for the Commission to permit intervention by Show Me. ¹ If such tactics are allowed, the Commission's dockets would be inundated with front groups seeking an opportunity to persuade the Commission of the view of its members under the guise of a "neutral and unbiased" party.

B. In its Motion to Reconsider, Show Me also relies upon the purported membership of the American Association of Retired Persons (AARP) and its representation of 710,000 members in Missouri. AARP was not, however, listed as a member of Show Me in the December 21, 1998 filing, and no information is

provided as to AARP's alleged membership in Show Me. Included as Attachments I and II to this Opposition, however, are letters from the AARP's Missouri State Legislative Committee and the AARP's Southwest Region's Missouri State Legislative Representative which make it abundantly clear that AARP is not a member of Show Me and did not authorize participation in this docket. Accordingly, AARP's purported membership does not withstand scrutiny as a basis for Show Me's intervention.

- C. Show Me also contends that two members of CompTel Missouri are not otherwise represented in the case. But Show Me has not even explained who the other members of CompTel are, although it has admitted that all but two are already parties to the case based on their status as certificated local exchange providers. Again, it would be wholly improper for the Commission to permit a front group for other parties in the case to have a second bite at the apple on the basis of two small interexchange carriers' membership in CompTel Missouri.
- D. Show Me's last attempt to justify its intervention relies upon a group called Missouri Citizen Action. SWBT notes that the group was called Citizen Action in Appendix A of the December 21,
 1998 Application to Intervene, but is now called Missouri Citizen Action in this Motion to Reconsider. No explanation of the change

in name is provided. Nor is any information on the members of Missouri Citizen Action provided, other than an unsupported assertion that it is "a statewide coalition of labor, senior citizen, consumer and community organizations, with combined membership of over 50,000 households." Show Me does not identify which consumer or community organizations are part of the Missouri Citizen Action, nor are the labor and senior citizen groups identified. Show Me has simply failed to explain who the members of Missouri Citizen Action are, what it takes to be considered a "member" of Missouri Citizen Action, or how the interests of Missouri Citizen Action are different from the public in general, as is required under 4 CSR 240-2.075 to support an intervention request.

5. In sum, Show Me has failed to justify its intervention in this case, despite being given a second opportunity by the Commission. Despite two attempts to explain its status, it remains clear that Show Me is a front group for entities which are otherwise represented in this case, with the exception of a purported citizen group about which no specific information has been supplied. The Commission's decision in this case will not be aided by giving AT&T and others the opportunity to participate in this case under its own name and through various associations. Nor has Show Me demonstrated compliance with applicable Commission rules to justify its intervention.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, SWBT respectfully requests the

Commission to deny the Motion to Reconsider the Application to Intervene of Show Me Competition, Inc.
