MOTION TO ALLOW PRE-FILING OF EXHIBIT

COMES NOW, the Office of Public Counsel (Public Counsel), and respectfully moves the Missouri Public Service Commission to admit the attached Exhibit into evidence in this case. This motion is made for the reason that, through November 28, 2000, Public Counsel has received approximately 100 letters from persons who state that their interests are affected by the City of Rolla's application for an Order Assigning the areas at issue in this matter. The senders of these letters oppose Rolla's application to become the sole provider of electric service to areas, which have been recently annexed into the Rolla city limits.

Although Public Counsel has not, to date, taken a position on whether the City of Rolla's application should be granted, the Office of Public Counsel believes that it is appropriate for this Commission to give due consideration to the wishes of the customers and property owners who will be affected by this Commission's decision. Public Counsel believes that the contents of this exhibit are relevant to the issues before the Commission in this proceeding, and so should be admitted into evidence.

Although the Commission conducted a public hearing in Rolla, Missouri, on October 24, 2000, several of the letter writers state that they were unable to attend the

public hearing. Others state that they were in attendance but did not speak on the record.

Because of the time frame in which these letters were received, Public Counsel was unable to file this proposed exhibit earlier in these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, the views of the customers who will be affected by this Commission's decision are relevant to the decision of this case, and should be given due consideration by the Commission. Therefore, it is respectfully moved that the attached Exhibit be admitted into evidence.

Dear Mr. Coffman:

I am told that those of us who did not testify at the meeting held at the Elks Club Loge in Rolla are likely not to be counted as those opposed to Rolla Municipal Utilities taking over as my supplier of electricity.

Longview Addition was the first subdivisions on the eastside of the Southside Annexation area. I bought the first lot to be sold. Our only supplier available was Intercounty Electric. They offered inducements to build an all electric home. It is not the cheapest form but it does have it advantages, such as a thermostat in each room, less circulation of dust, and little delay in bringing the temperature up to normal after turning it down. It would be a burden on us at our age, to rely upon the city of Rolla as our supplier. The cost that the city charges for residential customers does not conform to the prices that was circulating on paper at the meeting. Relying upon winter heat is scary. We have had short outage periods because of lines down, but never a supply failure that I can remember this past thirty years.

We are receiving rebates from Intercounty Electric for previous service in past years. I have no knowledge of Rolla Municipal Utilities making any rate changes, other than up.

The city of Rolla promised before the annexation vote, which carried by only 12votes, that rural areas could continue to carry on as before if annexed. We still have rural mail delivery, no water, and no sewer. The only improvement is streetlights and that was only to influence your department so that they could get a foot in the door. The city refused to annex three subdivisions on the westside when they requested it. To be able to swallow up subdivisions and rural land, they used those three subdivisions in need to out vote the less populated but higher acreage area. Of course this was legal, but it does show that they care little for people who spent money, just to get out of town. Some people had good-sized farms, and had only two votes. I have been paying city taxes since annexation, and receiving fewer benefits than we had from the county.

My reason for not offering testimony is that my hearing is bad and would have been embarrassing in trying to reply to questions. My testimony would have supported that of Gus Mueller who did testify.

The only city services we have to date, is street lighting which we do not need, and garbage service which we pay for.

I have a yard light that Intercounty Electric supplies for a monthly fee. I would lose the light should the city take over. The streetlight that the city placed in front of our house shines through our bedroom window. We have two choices, cover the window, or cover the large mirror on the dresser.

You can see by the tone of this letter, that I am not happy about annexation. I do believe that cities are necessary. I moved after building a new house at my present address thirty years ago. Hardly anyone likes to be molested in any way. Nobody can expect to live a lifetime without interruption. When I had a death threatening illness a little over a year ago, my wife called 911 at 4am one morning. I received a nasty letter from the chief of police and the city manager, blaming me because they had trouble finding me, though I had been in the city more than a year. They indicated that the service belonged to them, even though I had been paying a monthly fee on the telephone bill a number of years while I was served by the county system. The city council was having fistfights at their meeting when I moved here from Jefferson City in 1956. Lately, the only fights that I know of have been verbal. Maybe there is some chance of improvement. It took me some time to think of something that I could say good about the city before closing.

This case will state history and the most important point that you must make is that the overwhelming desires of the citizens determined the outcome, not the desires of a municipal government! One must put yourself in our shoes - you have voiced your opinion, you trusted the written information provided by the city prior to annexation - and now they want to change their minds! Why? Dear Mr. Coffman:

I would like to ask that you use this letter as my voice in your decision concerning the Rolla southside annexation area.

I would like to retain Intercounty Electric as my electric supplier in lieu of Rolla Municipal Utilities. Intercounty Electric has provided outstanding service, and has recently spent considerable funds clearing the lines to prevent power outages. I realize Rolla Municipal Utilities would provide a reasonable service. However, I do not believe RMU will provide the same quality of service. RMU and the City of Rolla have, what I call a utility jungle; poles and lines all over the area in every direction possible. Highway 72 is a prime example. One intersection has over ten poles of various uses.

Neither the City of Rolla or Intercounty Electric need to supply electric service to the same area as is currently happening. In my neighborhood, RMU has installed RMU lines for streetlights. Consequently, I am being surrounded with utility lines, Intercounty Electric lines in the back and RMU lines in the front. I don't know why RMU ran new lines instead of using Intercounty Electric for this service. Additionally, RMU recently ran an electric line to a new house being constructed in an area currently being serviced by Intercounty Electric. We do not need two utility companies supplying service to the same area. If Intercounty retains our households, they should provide service to the total area. Likewise, if RMU get our service, they need to get the total area.

I also find it very interesting that the City of Rolla is willing to take over the electric service to this area at no cost to the households. That is opposite from what they are doing with sewer and water. They are charging each household for sewer and water service

Thank you for your time. I hope this issue is resolved shortly.

The Rolla Municipal Utilities is owned by the City of Rolla and provides electric service for residential and commercial customers within the City limits of Rolla. RMU is governed by the Rolla Board of Public Works, which is a four member board approved by the Rolla City Council. RMU serves approximately 7,264 customers for an average 72 customers per mile of the electric distribution system. RMU currently has a total of 44 full time and 4 part-time employees. The RMU business office is staffed by 12 full time and 2 part-time employees and with the remaining employees working out of the service department. RMU maintains 101 miles of distribution lines that consist of 87.25 miles of overhead lines, 13.75 miles of underground lines and 10 substations. RMU is a full requirement contract customer of Union Electric Company. The electricity utilized in Rolla is purchased from Union Electric. This electricity supplied by Union Electric originates at multiple sources. These sources are Union Electric's Labadie coal-fired Missouri River generating plant, the Callaway County nuclear facility or Bagnell Dam at the Lake of the Ozarks. In addition, surplus power is frequently bought and sold from other electrical facilities. Rolla's electricity needs are but a small part of Union Electric's overall system demands. The local availability of electricity will not be a limiting factor relative to future development of the proposed annexation area.



Dear Fellas:

Well, I read in the paper that the Rolla Municipal Utilities is asking you for permission to kick Intercounty Electric Co-Op out of that new southside area the city just annexed. It says if you give RMU the okay, they can provide electricity to the south side folks instead of Intercounty. Now I just want to let you boys know that throwing those poor southside people to the tender mercies of the "Royal" Municipal Utilities is like hiring Lizzie Borden to run a day care center. I want you to know some of the reasons why it just wouldn't be neighborly to do that to those unsuspecting folks down the road.

The paper said that you will set a price for the buy-out of Intercounty's facilities if you let the RMU add the southside to their kingdom. Well, it won't be too hard to price the poles, lines, and such but I don't know how the hell you're going to put a price on all the good services Intercounty gives their owner-customers, and they get cash money back to boot! Surely, the quality of service you're going to swap here has to be figured in somehow? If not, it sure will be a shock to the southside people when they get a taste of what passes for electric service after you swap their Intercounty Cadillac for RMU's beat-up Yugo.

If you do set a price, you better find out first if RMU can pay the bill. Seems like I can remember when the utility cash reserves were around \$20 million but H. Dain and the good ole' boys have been dipping real hard into the reserves to give away millions to the city. Now they've only got about \$5 million left in case of an emergency. Like the one they're probably going to have one second after midnight on December 31.

I know that lawyer of theirs will blind you with numbers and figures but let me tell you how it looks from here. We're sitting here waiting for this Y2K to hit without the foggiest idea as to whether RMU has ever heard of a non-compliant chip not to mention whether they found any in that antique system of theirs. Just in the last ten months we've had a citywide, ten-hour blackout one cold day in January, another for 6 hours and since then too many rolling blackouts and water failures to count. I don't know whether to spend \$5,000 on the Deluxe Hunker-Down-They're-Comin-to-Get-Ya Y2K Survival Kit (AK-47 optional) or just take the wife to Florida and come back about May when RMU gets the power back on. My friends out in the county have been getting reports for over a year on every little widget Intercounty's tracked down and replaced to protect their people. Has RMU sent you any reports on this thing? If they have we'd take it kindly if you would send us a copy. We're gettin' real nervous about some of the old folks in town.

There's another real good reason you should turn down RMU's request, no matter what that city lawyer of theirs says. Whatever they charge those south side people, part of it isn't really for electricity. It's just a fee they add on to our bills so they have extra cash to send through the city hall laundry to pass over to RCDC - that's the Rolla Community Development Corporation. Now the name fools you into thinking that's a city development committee but that's nowhere near the truth. The RCDC is a private nonprofit corporation and they own Hy Point Industrial Park over by the city limits. That's right, city utility money goes direct to a private corporation. RCDC's stock is mostly owned by local bankers and chamber of commerce good ole' boys but here's your big surprise. The chairman of RCDC is H. Dain Ward, the very same guy who signed all those application papers of yours. First he overcharges us for electric and then he skims off \$600,000 annually (or sometimes a million or more) off our bills and while he's wearing his RMU Chairman hat he votes to send it over to the city as a "franchise payment." Sometimes they call it "Operating Transfers-City of Rolla" - sort of depends on which books you're looking at. Next he puts on one of his other hats like, Rolla Economic Developer or chairman of REDC, (that's the real city industrial development board) so he can make sure it gets put in the city budget for "economic development." Then he quick-like changes to his RCDC hat and the mayor hands the money back to him so he can spend it on some capital improvement project for his industrial park or they give it to one of the companies in his park for "rebates." They've got some secret contracts with these companies that say they get this big rate kickback and other things taxpayers paid for like free buildings. I'm sure you know about the Missouri Constitution Article VI, section 23, which says it's illegal to give public money or credit to private persons or corporations. It'd be real helpful if you'd read that out loud to them during your meeting but first you'll have to get their attention with a good smack upside the head. They don't like to hear about that law one bit.

Something else their lawyer won't tell you is that H. Dain Ward isn't a legitimate member of the RMU board and he hasn't been for some years. Once those boys spit in the eye of the constitution and got away with it, it was real easy to break all the rest of the state laws. Like 97.470, the one that says the members of the public works board can't hold any other city appointment because if they do, their seat on the RMU board is "ipso facto" vacated. It says the same thing in our city ordinance - ipso facto and all. Mr. Ward doesn't have just one other city appointment he has two besides the utility board. The city council is scared spitless so they just keep appointing him and pretend they can't hear the sound of all those laws breaking. I figure all his city appointments and that ipso facto law might be a sticky problem for you fellas. What if people find out you granted a request by someone who, not only has conflict-of-interest oozing out his ears, but he signed your official state documents pretending to be on a public board that he "ipso factoed" himself out of years ago? If I were you I'd think about how much that signature of his is worth.

But, because we're living in the finest little pork barrel city in the Ozarks, ole' H. Dain is still right there on the city utility board bold as brass. No matter what the law says he's gonna cling to that utility seat like a barnacle at high tide. He and his RCDC buddies know if he's not on the RMU board their money pipeline will plumb rust out. So H. Dain just keeps right on having his secret meetings and raising our utility rates without public

hearings. Wearing all those hats has puffed up his head so much that I hear he told Intercounty they could keep their electric service on the southside on condition that...... Well, if you can get that slippery customer under oath ask him if he didn't offer to spare Intercounty all this bother, and they could keep their own property to boot, if they would just slip RMU an annual cash "contribution" the same as what RMU would have raked off the south side utility bills. That way H. Dain and his RCDC buddies could get the money without the bother of having to supply the electricity. Can you imagine Intercounty turning down a great deal like that? Well, they did, so H. Dain called it an "unsuccessful negotiation." That's not what we call it. Down here we shoot varmints that promise not to kill your chickens if you just let them suck the eggs dry. Now I ask you, are these the kind of money-skimming, law-breaking connivers you want to hand those poor people over to?

I about busted a gut laughing when I read RMU said "this action was being taken after numerous requests from residents in the area for RMU to provide electric service,..." That's not what I hear they said. The city and the utilities told all of us a pack of lies about how annexation wouldn't cost much but right after the dirty deed was done the real figures came out. Now if there's anything we know about RMU besides power failures, it's that they lie like bar girls pushing cheap whisky. For example, this year they've been running ads to tell us they're a non-profit corporation. The RMU manager, Dan Watkins was asked to produce these alleged incorporation papers. Caught flat-footed holding the lying bag, Watkins confessed they weren't a non-profit corporation but he said they were like an "agent" for the city. Uh-huh.

We don't know which genius came up with that honker but we do know why they're trying to give their image a face-lift. Just over a year ago a local resident, Robert Nash, started an on-line newsletter called "No Standing News." Last year just after the mayor announced he would appoint H. Dain Ward to his third city position – this one with a salary - Nash published an article on the interlocking connections between the utility board, city hall and RCDC. That expose really got the mayor's knickers in a twist since the story starred his pal H. Dain Ward. Ward still got appointed but didn't get the salary.

Gentlemen/Ladies:

In a recent article in the Rolla Daily News, we noticed that Rolla Municipal Utilities is petitioning you for permission to take over the recently annexed area on the south side of Rolla from Intercounty Electric Coop. The article stated that they were doing so because they had received numerous complaints from residents of the affected area concerning the service provided by Intercounty.

By no means do we know all of the residents of the annexed area, but we have lived here and been served by Intercounty since 1981. In all these years, we have no complaints about the service provided us by Intercounty—nor have we heard any of our friends and neighbors served by Intercounty complain about the service they have received.

Shortly after we were "taken in" by the City of Rolla, we were sent documents giving us the opportunity to choose whether we wanted to be served by RMU or by Intercounty. We chose Intercounty because of the excellent service they have provided for so many years. It seems that perhaps a great number of our neighbors must have also chosen Intercounty and that RMU didn't get the "mandate" they were hoping for. So they have decided now to try to preempt Intercounty and "go around" the residents of the affected area by going directly to you for your blessing to proceed in separating us from the excellent service Intercounty consistently gives.

We have no axe to grind with the individuals at RMU—but we certainly have no axe to grind with Intercounty. The few power failures we have experienced since 1981 have all been weather/storm related, and our service has been quickly restored each time. However, we work in the City of Rolla and have experienced quite a number of power failures in our workplaces which are served by RMU. There have been occasions when the power was off in the City for many hours.

In fact, one memorable utage a few months ago cost all the rocers in the City thousands of dollars as all their frozen and refrigerated food was lost due to RMU's failure to restore power in a timely fashion.

Given our experience with Intercounty, it is our preference to remain as members of the Intercounty Electric Coop. Please carefully consider this matter before automatically handing us over to RMU. My dad used to have an old country saying that seems to be fitting in this situation, "If it ain't broke, don't fix it." As far as we are concerned, our electric service is not broken—please don't "fix" it with the not-so-reliable service provided by RMU.

I would like to ask that you use this letter as my voice in your decision concerning the Rolla southside annexation area.

I would like to retain Intercounty Electric as my electric supplier in lieu of Rolla Municipal Utilities. Intercounty Electric has provided outstanding service, and has recently spent considerable funds clearing the lines to prevent power outages. I realize Rolla Municipal Utilities would provide a reasonable service. However, I do not believe RMU will provide the same quality of service. RMU and the City of Rolla have, what I call a utility jungle; poles and lines all over the area in every direction possible. Highway 72 is a prime example. One intersection has over ten poles of various uses.

Neither the City of Rolla or Intercounty Electric need to supply electric service to the same area as is currently happening. In my neighborhood, RMU has installed RMU lines for streetlights. Consequently, I am being surrounded with utility lines, Intercounty Electric lines in the back and RMU lines in the front. I don't know why RMU ran new lines instead of using Intercounty Electric for this service. Additionally, RMU recently ran an electric line to a new house being constructed in an area currently being serviced by Intercounty Electric. We do not need two utility companies supplying service to the same area. If Intercounty retains our households, they should provide service to the total area. Likewise, if RMU get our service, they need to get the total area.

I also find it very interesting that the City of Rolla is willing to take over the electric service to this area at no cost to the households. That is opposite from what they are doing with sewer and water. They are charging each household for sewer and water service.
