NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

On May 5, 2010, the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a complaint against 5 Star Homes and Development Company, Inc. The company filed a timely response; however, the response was not filed by an attorney.

Commission rule¹ allows non-attorneys to only represent themselves and not a corporation. Because 5 Star Homes is a corporation, an attorney is required to appear before the Commission. Although the answer may serve to provide information to the Director of Manufactured Housing, it cannot serve as an answer for Commission purposes. The Commission therefore urges 5 Star to directly contact the Director of Manufactured Housing to discuss this matter, which may obviate the need for 5 Star to hire an attorney.

If, however, the parties are unable resolve this matter without the Commission's guidance, then 5 Star must hire an attorney to proceed. In which case, the Commission will

allow 5 Star to file an answer out of time. The Commission will then set a prehearing conference at which the hearing process will be discussed, as well as a hearing date.
