## MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES' COMMENTS

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-20.100, respectfully submits the following comments in response to the 2012 Compliance Report of Ameren Missouri (Ameren).

- 1. MDNR confirms that it has certified all renewable energy generation facilities referred to in Ameren's Compliance Report, including Keokuk Energy Park, Pioneer Prairie Wind Farm 1, Maryland Heights Renewable Energy Center (MHREC), Ameren Missouri General Office Building Solar, solar RECs from Ameren's customers, and solar RECs from out-of-state solar facilities pursuant to 10 CSR 140-8.010.
- 2. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-20.100 (7)(A)1.D., "for the RECs and S-RECs, a calculated REC or S-REC value for each source and each category of REC" shall be provided. In Section (7)(A)1.D. of Ameren's Compliance Report, no explicit statement regarding the value of RECs generated from MHREC has been found.
- 3. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-20.100 (7)(A)2, it requires "on the same date that the electric utility files its annual RES compliance report, the

utility shall post an electronic copy of its annual RES compliance report, excluding highly confidential or proprietary material, on its website to facilitate public access and review". As of this date, Ameren has not yet posted its 2012 compliance report on its website (see http://www.ameren.com/Environment/Pages/RenewablesatAmeren.aspx). Ameren should post the 2012 compliance report.
