**MOTION TO AMEND APPLICATION**

COMES NOW Sprint Missouri, Inc. ("Sprint"), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(20), and respectfully seeks leave from the Missouri Public Service Commission to file *instanter* the attached Amended Application for Competitive Classification with accompanying attachments. The Amended Application varies from the original Application as follows:

1. All references to the Fort Leonard Wood exchange are deleted from the Amended Application. Those references appeared on pages 1, 4 and 5 of the original Application.
2. All references to the Fort Leonard Wood exchange are deleted from the proposed tariff attached to the Amended Application.
3. Any references to the "Application" are pervasively amended to refer to the "Amended Application."
4. The effect of deleting the Fort Leonard Wood exchange from the Amended Application is to narrow the scope of the relief sought by Sprint and to reduce the number of issues that must be evaluated and decided by the Commission. Similarly, the parties and intervenors will have fewer issues to evaluate and address.




5. No party, intervenor or consumer in the State of Missouri can be prejudiced by allowing Sprint to amend its Application and accompanying tariff as requested.

6. This amendment should not delay the processing and ultimate decision on Sprint's Amended Application. It should still be approved within 30 days of the original filing on August 30, 2005. That is because the public, the Commission, all parties and intervenors have received timely notice of all relief sought by Sprint. The proposed amendment reduces the scope of the request for relief and asks for nothing additional at this time.

WHEREFORE, Sprint respectfully requests that its Motion to Amend Application be granted and that the attached Amended Application, the accompanying exhibits and the revised tariff be filed *instanter*. The schedule for the proceeding should not be revised should the Motion to Amend be granted.



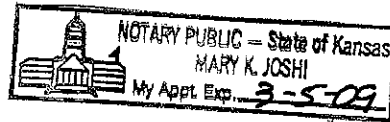

**AMENDED APPLICATION FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION**

COMES NOW Sprint Missouri, Inc. ("Sprint") and hereby requests the Commission approve Sprint's Amended Application for Competitive Classification and attached tariff pursuant to Section 392.245.5 RSMo. (2005) for all its residential services, other than exchange access service, for the following exchanges: (a) Ferrelview, (b) Platte City, and (c) Weston; and for all of its business services, other than exchange access services, in the following exchanges: (a) St. Robert, (b) Waynesville, (c) Platte City and (d) Ferrelview<sup>1</sup>. In support of its Application, Sprint states as follows:

1. Sprint is a public utility, and a telecommunications company, as those terms are defined in Section 386.020(42) and (51), RSMo 2000. Sprint is a large incumbent local exchange telecommunications company and is subject to Price Cap Regulation under Section 392.245

2. Missouri statute Section 392.245.5 RSMo. (2005) allows carriers subject to Price Cap Regulation to seek competitive classification for each telecommunications service offered to business and residential customers, other than exchange access service, in any exchange in which at least two non-affiliated entities are providing basic local telecommunications service to customers within the exchange. Sprint faces growing and intense competition from at least two non-affiliated entities in all the exchanges listed

above. Specifically, at least one non-affiliated wireless carrier is providing service in all the exchanges. Furthermore, Sprint's primary wireline competitors in these exchanges are cable operators that are providing local phone service via their own facilities over the same cable which provides cable-TV/cable-broadband service or facilities-based CLECs.

Section 392.245.5 RSMo. (2005) states as follows:

5. Each telecommunications service offered to business customers, other than exchange access service, of an incumbent local exchange telecommunications company regulated under this section shall be classified as competitive in any exchange in which at least two non-affiliated entities in addition to the incumbent local exchange company are providing basic local telecommunications service to business customers within the exchange. Each telecommunications service offered to residential customers, other than exchange access service, of an incumbent local exchange telecommunications company regulated under this section shall be classified as competitive in an exchange in which at least two non-affiliated entities in addition to the incumbent local exchange company are providing basic local telecommunications service to residential customers within the exchange. For purposes of this subsection:

(1) Commercial mobile service providers as identified in 47 U.S.C. Section 332(d)(1) and 47 C.F.R. Parts 22 or 24 shall be considered as entities providing basic local telecommunications service, provided that only one such non-affiliated provider shall be considered as providing basic local telecommunications service within an exchange;

(2) Any entity providing local voice service in whole or in part over telecommunications facilities or other facilities in which it or one of its affiliates have an ownership interest shall be considered as a basic local telecommunications service provider regardless of whether such entity is subject to regulation by the commission. A provider of local voice service that requires the use of a third party, unaffiliated broadband network or dial-up Internet network for the origination of local voice service shall not be considered a basic local telecommunications service provider. For purposes of this subsection only, a broadband network is defined as a connection that delivers services at speeds exceeding two hundred kilobits per second in at least one direction;



(3) Regardless of the technology utilized, local voice service shall mean two-way voice service capable of receiving calls from a provider of basic local telecommunications services as defined by subdivision (4) of section 386.020, RSMo;

(4) Telecommunications companies only offering prepaid telecommunications service or only reselling telecommunications service as defined in subdivision (46) of section 386.020, RSMo, in the exchange being considered for competitive classification shall not be considered entities providing basic telecommunications service; and

(5) Prepaid telecommunications service shall mean a local service for which payment is made in advance that excludes access to operator assistance and long distance service;

(6) Upon request of an incumbent local exchange telecommunications company seeking competitive classification of business service or residential service, or both, the commission shall, within thirty days of the request, determine whether the requisite number of entities are providing basic local telecommunications service to business or residential customers, or both, in an exchange and if so, shall approve tariffs designating all such business or residential services other than exchange access service, as competitive within such exchange.

3. Section 392.245.5(1) RSMo. (2005) states that commercial mobile service providers shall be considered as entities providing basic local telecommunications service, provided that only one such non-affiliated provider shall be considered as providing basic local telecommunications service within an exchange. Sprint has numerous non-affiliated wireless providers operating in its exchanges providing local service. Exhibit A identifies wireless carriers, including (a) Cingular, (b) Verizon, (c) T-Mobile, (d) Alltel, and (e) US Cellular providing local service in the above Sprint exchanges. (See Exhibit A for Wireless Carriers Operating in Sprint Exchanges)

4. Section 392.245.5(2) RSMo. (2005) allows any wireline carrier providing local phone service in whole or in part over telecommunications facilities it owns to be considered as entities providing basic local telecommunications service, including cable



operators that are also providing local phone service. Specific to this Application, Time Warner Cable is providing residential phone service, using facilities it owns in part or whole, in the following Sprint exchanges: (a) Ferrelview, (b) Platte City, and (c) Weston. Furthermore, Fidelity Communications is providing business phone service, using facilities it owns in part or whole, in the following Sprint exchange: (a) St. Robert, and (b) Waynesville,. Finally, ExOp Communication is providing residential and business phone service, using facilities it owns in part, or whole in the following Sprint exchanges: (a) Platte City, and (b) Ferrelview. Each of these carriers are discussed in detail below:

a. Time Warner Cable provides local phone service to residential customers in direct competition with Sprint in the following Sprint exchanges: a) Ferrelview, (b) Platte City, and (c) Weston:

i. Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri) LLC (“Time Warner Cable”) obtained a Certificate to Provide Basic Local, Local Exchange, and Interexchange Telecommunications Services within Missouri, including the exchanges of Sprint, on March 2, 2004 (Case No. LA-2004-0133).

ii. Time Warner Cable is not a reseller of Sprint’s services but uses a combination of its own facilities and facilities of other providers. Time Warner Cable has its own facilities extensively deployed throughout the above mentioned exchanges. Time Warner Cable is not relying upon unbundled network elements from Sprint but rather is using Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) technology.



- iii. The Commission has previously found that Time Warner Cable is, in fact, providing local service in Sprint's exchanges when the Commission granted Sprint's request for geographic price flexibility in Case No. TO-2005-0290.
  - iv. Based upon a combination of Time Warner Cable's website and Time Warner Cable's 2004 Annual Report, it is providing service in the following Sprint exchanges: a) Ferrelview, (b) Platte City, and (c) Weston. (See Exhibit B)
- b. Fidelity provides local phone service to business customers in direct competition with Sprint in the following Sprint exchanges:
- (a) St. Robert, and (b) Waynesville:
    - i. Fidelity Communications Services I obtained a Certificate to Provide Basic Local, Local Exchange, and Interexchange Telecommunications Services within Missouri, including the exchanges of Sprint, on November 30, 1999 (Case No. TA-2000-191):
    - ii. Fidelity's 2004 Annual Report identifies local business customers in the following Sprint exchanges: (a) St. Robert, and (b) Waynesville. (See Exhibit C for Fidelity's 2004 Annual Report). The Annual Report indicates that Fidelity has its own facilities and is not relying upon unbundled network elements from Sprint.



c. ExOp of Missouri dba Unite provides local phone service to business and residential customers in direct competition with Sprint in Sprint's Platte City and Ferrelview exchanges:

- i. ExOp of Missouri was certificated by the Commission in Case No. TA-97-193 to provide basic local telecommunications services in Missouri, including Sprint's exchanges, and the Commission approved an interconnection agreement between Sprint and ExOp in Case No. TO-98-382.
- ii. ExOp of Missouri's 2004 Annual Report identifies local residential and business customers in the Sprint exchanges of Platte City and Ferrelview. The Annual Report indicates that ExOp is providing service in both these exchanges with its own facilities and is not relying upon unbundled network elements from Sprint. (See Exhibit D for ExOp's 2004 Annual Report).


5. Sprint's Application for Competitive Classification is not a request for any price changes and the accompanying tariff (Exhibit E) reflects administrative changes only indicating the new competitive classification. In fact, Sprint acknowledges that all rates currently in effect for these exchanges will remain in effect until such time Sprint files a tariff requesting a price change. Sprint will be required to file tariffs for any future price changes, either increases or decreases, associated with these exchanges which will continue to require Commission approval. Furthermore, Sprint will be required to notify its customers of any future price increase.



WHEREFORE Sprint respectfully requests the Commission approve Sprint's Amended Application for Competitive Classification and related tariff pursuant to Section 392.245.5 RSMo. (2005). Sprint has demonstrated that at least two non-affiliated entities are providing basic local telecommunications service to customers within each of the exchanges. Sprint's Amended Application and tariff meets the statutory requirements for competitive classification and should become effective in no more than 30 days.

Competitive Local Exchange Carrier Access Line Report**

**I. BACKGROUND**

In opening local telephone markets to competition, the Missouri Public Service Commission (MoPSC) is interested in determining and tracking the amount of actual competition occurring throughout the state. For a variety of reasons including but not limited to statutory reasons, the MoPSC finds it necessary to track the level of competition in local telephone markets.

**II. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this portion of the Annual Report is to ascertain, on an exchange specific basis, the number of voice-grade equivalent access lines in service being provided by your company in each exchange (as identified in your tariff) in Missouri. Information is sought for residential and business voice-grade equivalent access lines on an exchange-by-exchange basis. **Please use the common exchange name as shown in your tariffs.** Further, information is sought on the following ways of provisioning each access line: (A) pure resale lines; (B) unbundled network element lines (UNE); (C) unbundled network element platform lines (UNE-P); and, (D) pure facility based lines. **Please report on a separate line the number of company used lines.**

**III. WHAT IS MEANT BY "VOICE TELEPHONE SERVICE"?**

Voice telephone service means local exchange or exchange access services that allow end users to originate and terminate local telephone calls on the public switched telephone network, whether used by the end user for telephone calls or for other types of calls carried over the public switched network (for example, lines used for facsimile equipment and "dial-up" internet lines).

**IV. WHAT IS MEANT BY "VOICE-GRADE" EQUIVALENT LINES?**

You are to report voice-grade equivalent lines. Count as one voice-grade equivalent line: traditional analog POTS lines, Centrex-CO extensions, and Centrex-CU trunks. Count lines based on how they are charged to the customer rather than how they are physically provisioned. For example, count Basic Rate Integrated (BRI) and Digital Network (ISDN) Services lines as two voice-grade equivalent lines. Report 8 voice-grade equivalent lines if a customer buys 8 trunks that happen to be provisioned over a DS1 circuit. If a customer buys a DS1 circuit that is provided as channelized service, report 24 voice-grade equivalent lines, even if there is some indication that the customer is only using 8 of the derived lines. Thus, a voice-grade equivalent line is a line that directly connects an end user to a carrier and allows the end user to originate and terminate local telephone calls on the public switched network.

Voice-grade equivalent lines include high capacity (DS1, DS-3, etc.) lines that are channelized to provide voice-grade service. In such instances, it is the number of channels available for voice traffic to/from the public switched network that should be counted as voice-grade equivalent access lines. **Note for competitive LEC's providing local exchange service over hybrid fiber-coaxial cable television systems:** Count your records and report how many voice-grade equivalent lines are being billed.

**V. WHAT IS MEANT BY PURE RESALE VOICE GRADE EQUIVALENT LINES?**

Pure resold lines are those lines provided pursuant to § 251 (c)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. Pure resold lines are those lines not owned or controlled by the telephone company billing the end user for the service. Pure resold lines are typically leased from an underlying carrier at a wholesale discount off the tariffed rate. The use of resold lines exclusively provides a means to offer service without owning or controlling any equipment. Pure resold lines are those lines provided under a general or local exchange tariff, but without benefit of an accompanying switched access tariff.

**VI. WHAT IS MEANT BY UNBUNDLED NETWORK ELEMENT (UNE) LINES?**

UNE lines are those lines where the carrier provides some portion of the equipment required to provide telephone service. The most common example is a competitive LEC who provides the switching but leases a loop (or extended loop) from the incumbent LEC. UNE loops are obtained on a stand alone basis and service is provided to the end user without combining other UNEs. Service provisioned over UNE loops requires the carrier to lease a loop from another LEC in order to connect the customer to the carrier's own switch. UNE lines are provided under a general or local exchange tariff in combination with a switched access tariff.

**VII. WHAT IS MEANT BY UNE-P VOICE GRADE EQUIVALENT LINES?**

UNE Platform (UNE-P) lines are those lines utilizing a combination of UNEs so that service provisioned over UNE-P lines does not require the carrier to use its own switch, port, or loop. UNE-P lines are commonly used by competitive LECs. UNE-P lines are provided under a general or local exchange tariff in combination with a switched access tariff.

**VIII. WHAT IS MEANT BY FULL FACILITY BASED VOICE GRADE EQUIVALENT LINES?**

Full facility based lines are those lines owned or controlled exclusively by a local exchange carrier and used to connect to an end user's premises. Count as your own such facilities, those facilities that you actually owned as well as facilities such as dark fiber that you obtained the right to use from other entities. Do not include, as full facilities based lines, lines provided over UNE loops that you obtained from another carrier. Full facility based lines are provided under a general or local exchange tariff in conjunction with a switched access tariff.

**IX. WHAT IS MEANT BY PUBLIC ACCESS LINES?**

Some carriers (particularly incumbent carriers) still separate pay telephone lines from business lines. Use this column to report pay telephone lines if your company tariffs reflect pay telephone lines distinct from business lines.

**X. WHAT IS MEANT BY EXCHANGE?**

"Exchange" as defined in Missouri Revised Statutes §386.020(16), is a geographical area for the administration of telecommunications services, established and described by the tariff of a telecommunications company providing basic local telecommunications service.

**I. BACKGROUND**

In opening local telephone markets to competition, the Missouri Public Service Commission (MoPSC) is interested in determining and tracking the amount of actual competition occurring throughout the state. For a variety of reasons including but not limited to statutory reasons, the MoPSC finds it necessary to track the level of competition in local telephone markets.

**II. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this portion of the Annual Report is to ascertain, on an exchange specific basis, the number of voice-grade equivalent access lines in service being provided by your company in each exchange (as identified in your tariff) in Missouri. Information is sought for residential and business voice-grade equivalent access lines on an exchange-by-exchange basis. **Please use the common exchange name as shown in your tariffs.** Further, information is sought on the following ways of provisioning each access line: (A) pure resale lines; (B) unbundled network element lines (UNE); (C) unbundled network element platform lines (UNE-P); and, (D) pure facility based lines. **Please report on a separate line the number of company used lines.**

**III. WHAT IS MEANT BY "VOICE TELEPHONE SERVICE"?**

Voice telephone service means local exchange or exchange access services that allow end users to originate and terminate local telephone calls on the public switched telephone network, whether used by the end user for telephone calls or for other types of calls carried over the public switched network (for example, lines used for facsimile equipment and "dial-up" internet lines).

**IV. WHAT IS MEANT BY "VOICE-GRADE" EQUIVALENT LINES?**

You are to report voice-grade equivalent lines. Count as one voice-grade equivalent line: traditional analog POTS lines, Centrex-CO extensions, and Centrex-CU trunks. Count lines based on how they are charged to the customer rather than how they are physically provisioned. For example, count Basic Rate Integrated (BRI) and Digital Network (ISDN) Services lines as two voice-grade equivalent lines. Report 8 voice-grade equivalent lines if a customer buys 8 trunks that happen to be provisioned over a DS1 circuit. If a customer buys a DS1 circuit that is provided as channelized service, report 24 voice-grade equivalent lines, even if there is some indication that the customer is only using 8 of the derived lines. Thus, a voice-grade equivalent line is a line that directly connects an end user to a carrier and allows the end user to originate and terminate local telephone calls on the public switched network.

Voice-grade equivalent lines include high capacity (DS1, DS-3, etc.) lines that are channelized to provide voice-grade service. In such instances, it is the number of channels available for voice traffic to/from the public switched network that should be counted as voice-grade equivalent access lines. **Note for competitive LEC's providing local exchange service over hybrid fiber-coaxial cable television systems: Count your records and report how many voice-grade equivalent lines are being billed.**

**V. WHAT IS MEANT BY PURE RESALE VOICE GRADE EQUIVALENT LINES?**

Pure resold lines are those lines provided pursuant to § 251 (c)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. Pure resold lines are those lines not owned or controlled by the telephone company billing the end user for the service. Pure resold lines are typically leased from an underlying carrier at a wholesale discount off the tariffed rate. The use of resold lines exclusively provides a means to offer service without owning or controlling any equipment. Pure resold lines are those lines provided under a general or local exchange tariff, but without benefit of an accompanying switched access tariff.

**VI. WHAT IS MEANT BY UNBUNDLED NETWORK ELEMENT (UNE) LINES?**

UNE lines are those lines where the carrier provides some portion of the equipment required to provide telephone service. The most common example is a competitive LEC who provides the switching but leases a loop (or extended loop) from the incumbent LEC. UNE loops are obtained on a stand alone basis and service is provided to the end user without combining other UNEs. Service provisioned over UNE loops requires the carrier to lease a loop from another LEC in order to connect the customer to the carrier's own switch. UNE lines are provided under a general or local exchange tariff in combination with a switched access tariff.

**VII. WHAT IS MEANT BY UNE-P VOICE GRADE EQUIVALENT LINES?**

UNE Platform (UNE-P) lines are those lines utilizing a combination of UNEs so that service provisioned over UNE-P lines does not require the carrier to use its own switch, port, or loop. UNE-P lines are commonly used by competitive LECs. UNE-P lines are provided under a general or local exchange tariff in combination with a switched access tariff.

**VIII. WHAT IS MEANT BY FULL FACILITY BASED VOICE GRADE EQUIVALENT LINES?**

Full facility based lines are those lines owned or controlled exclusively by a local exchange carrier and used to connect to an end user's premises. Count as your own such facilities, those facilities that you actually owned as well as facilities such as dark fiber that you obtained the right to use from other entities. Do not include, as full facilities based lines, lines provided over UNE loops that you obtained from another carrier. Full facility based lines are provided under a general or local exchange tariff in conjunction with a switched access tariff.

**IX. WHAT IS MEANT BY PUBLIC ACCESS LINES?**

Some carriers (particularly incumbent carriers) still separate pay telephone lines from business lines. Use this column to report pay telephone lines if your company tariffs reflect pay telephone lines distinct from business lines.

**X. WHAT IS MEANT BY EXCHANGE?**

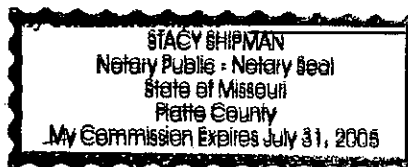
