LATE-FILED APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF MIDWEST GAS USERS' ASSOCIATION

Comes now MIDWEST GAS USERS' ASSOCIATION ("Midwest") and pursuant to 4 C.S.R. 240-2.075 applies to intervene herein and become a party hereto in respect to the above matter. In support thereof, Midwest respectfully states:

- 1. Midwest is an unincorporated non-profit association consisting of and representing its membership of business concerns and corporations which are substantial users of natural gas at their plants situated in such states as Kansas, Missouri and Oklahoma of which numerous members have plants and facilities which are located in and consume natural gas within the State of Missouri. As currently required by 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), a listing of Midwest' member firms and participants is attached hereto as Appendix A.1/
- 2. Midwest's interest on behalf of its members and participants in proceedings affecting the rates, terms and

conditions of natural gas service has been repeatedly recognized by the Missouri Public Service Commission in permitting Midwest's intervention in proceedings affecting Missouri Gas Energy and its predecessors, the Missouri Public Service Company, fein the prior rate case of AmerenUE, GR-98-393, and in various generic dockets involving the terms and conditions of natural gas transportation and purchased gas adjustment clauses for natural gas companies in the State of Missouri. Furthermore, Midwest's interest in proceedings affecting natural gas rates, and the terms and conditions of natural gas service has been recognized by the Federal Power Commission and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in granting Midwest's intervention in numerous dockets concerning Williams Natural Gas Pipeline Company, Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Company, and in other generic dockets concerning the terms and conditions of natural gas service, including Orders 436, 500, 451, 528, and Order 636.

- 3. On or about February 18, 2000 Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (UE) filed proposed tariffs reflecting an overall annual revenue increase of \$12 million for its Missouri service area. Approval of several other modifications to transportation tariffs were also requested by UE, which changes may affect the costs incurred by Midwest members and participants to transport their natural gas supplies through UE facilities.
- 4. As major customers of UE, Midwest participants and members will be affected by the outcome of this docket to a material but as yet undetermined extent.

5. Because UE transports gas for consumption to Midwest members under separate rate schedules and because of the size of Midwest's members, Midwest is in the special position of representing interests which will not and cannot be represented adequately by any other party and which interest is direct and immediate and different than those of the general public. Therefore, it will aid the Commission and protect the public interest that Midwest be permitted to intervene in this proceeding so as to protect interests which no other party is in a position properly to protect and adequately represent herein.

Cause for Late Filing

6. The Commission's Order of March 3, 2000, directed interventions to be filed by March 23, 2000. Although provided a copy of the Company's filing, unavailability of personnel necessary to analyze the impact of that filing and make decisions regarding intervention due to previously scheduled leave and business travel and leave has delayed receipt of formal authorization for this intervention. This intervention is submitted on March 28, 2000, two (2) business days following the due date previously ordered by the Commission, but is nevertheless within the thirty (30) day period otherwise established by 4 CSR 240-2.075(1). In addition, counsel for UE has been contacted and has stated that UE has no objection to this application to intervene being late-filed. It is not believed that any significant action has occurred in this case that this intervention would disrupt, delay or impede and no prejudice to any party could or will

result from allowing this application to intervene to be latefiled.

WHEREFORE, Midwest prays: (a) that Midwest be permitted to intervene herein and be made a party hereto with all rights to have notice of and participate in hearings to present evidence, cross-examine witnesses, file briefs and participate in argument, should any be had; and (b) for all other needful and proper relief.
