Enclosed for filing is <u>P.S.C. MO. No. 5 Consolidated</u>, <u>Eighteenth Revised Sheet No. 12</u>, which is applicable to both divisions of Laclede Gas Company ("Company").

This revised tariff sheet, which has an issue date of November 9, 2011 and an effective date of January 13, 2012, is being filed to change the Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS") in accordance with Sections 393.1009, 393.1012 and 393.1015 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri. A full explanation of the surcharge being proposed by the Company is set forth in the *Verified Application and Petition of Laclede Gas Company to Change Its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge*, which is being filed separately today. As proposed herein, the ISRS would increase the typical residential heating customer's bill by 25 cents per month or less than one-half of 1%.

Please bring this filing to the attention of the appropriate Commission personnel.

## INFRASTRUCTURE SYSTEM REPLACEMENT SURCHARGE ("ISRS")

<u>Description</u>: The ISRS is designed to recover the costs associated with the Company's eligible infrastructure replacements in accordance with the provisions of Sections 393.1009 to 393.1015, RSMo.

<u>Applicability</u>: In addition to the other charges provided for in the Company's tariff, a monthly ISRS shall be added to each customer's bill for service rendered on and after the effective date of the ISRS.

<u>Schedule of Surcharges</u>: The amount of the ISRS by rate schedule is as follows:
