At a prehearing conference on December 10, 2007, the presiding officer directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than December 17. On that date, the Commission's Staff, acting on behalf of the other parties, filed a motion asking for an extension of time to file the proposed procedural schedule. Staff explains the parties are discussing the filing of a stipulation and ask that they be allowed until December 21 to file a proposed procedural schedule or other pleading.
