**ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL
TIME FOR RESPONSES**

On June 30, 2009, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed an application for review and reversal of the decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator to withhold numbering resources. On July 13, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a Staff Recommendation requesting the Commission deny AT&T Missouri's request. On July 16, 2009, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a response supporting Staff's recommendation. On July 20, 2009 AT&T Missouri filed a response to Staff's Recommendation asking for additional time to provide a supplement to its response.

The Commission will grant AT&T Missouri's request for additional time to respond to Staff's recommendation. In addition, the Commission will direct Staff to file a recommendation or status report stating the earliest date on which they

can file a recommendation to AT&T Missouri's supplemental response. The responses shall be filed as set out below.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri shall file its supplemental responses to Staff's Motion to Cancel VoIP Registration shall be filed no later than Friday, July 24, 2009.

2. Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation or status report no later than **4:30 p.m.** Tuesday, July 28, 2009.

3. Any other party responses to AT&T Missouri's supplemental response shall be filed no later than **4:30 p.m.** Tuesday, July 28, 2009.

4. This order shall be effective upon issuance.
