The Commission issued a Report and Order on March 7, 2012, which bears an effective date April 6.¹ On March 9, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed phase-in tariffs effective June 25, 2012, as permitted by the Report and Order.² On March 12, the Commission ordered responses to the tariffs no later than March 19.

The Staff of the Commission ("Staff") filed a recommendation on March 19, stating that the Commission should approve the specific tariff sheets identified therein. Also on March 19, AG Processing, Inc., ("AGP") responded, stating that it would be inappropriate and possibly unlawful to approve tariff sheets before the effective date of the Report and Order. Further, AGP stated that it intended to file a timely application for rehearing.

AGP did not file an application for rehearing before the Report and Order became effective. AGP moved to suspend or reject the tariff sheets on April 9. That objection, however, is nothing more than an untimely collateral attack on the Report and
