MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

COMES NOW Southern Union Company ("Southern Union") and for its Motion that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issue its customary Protective Order in the captioned case, states as follows:

- 1. On July 20, 1999, Southern Union filed an Application for authority to acquire up and including five percent (5%) of the common stock of Pennsylvania Enterprises, Inc. ("PNT"). This Application was filed in conjunction with a separate Application for authority for Southern Union and PNT to pursue a statutory merger, which companion case has been docketed by the Commission as Case No. GM-2000-43.
- 2. Subsequent to the filing of a July 29, 1999, <u>Staff Recommendation</u>, the Commission issued an <u>Order Approving Application with Additional Conditions</u> on July 29, 1999, which Order was subsequently modified by an Order dated 24, 1999.
- 3. The conditions established by the Commission require that Southern Union periodically file certain financial documentation associated with the investments made by Southern Union pursuant to the Commission's approval. Because the information required to be filed by Southern Union is likely to include information which is considered to be confidential or proprietary in nature, Southern Union requests that the Commission issue its customary Protective Order to facilitate prompt compliance with the Commission's various filing requirements set forth in the July

29, 1999, Order Approving Application with Additional Conditions.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, Southern Union requests that the Commission issue its customary Protective Order in the captioned cause.
