MOTION TO OPEN DOCKET

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and for this Motion to Open Docket states as follows:

- 1. The Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") has the authority to establish a docket for the purpose of receiving information from public utilities under its jurisdiction pursuant to Section 393.140 RSMo (1994). Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company ("MGE") is a gas corporation as defined in Section 386.020(18) RSMO (Supp. 1998) and, as such, is a public utility subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Section 386.020(42) RSMo (Supp. 1998).
 - 2. MGE provides natural gas service in the City of Kansas City, Missouri.
- 3. On July 26, 1999, at approximately 8:09 p.m., an explosion and fire occurred at 101 East 41st Street, Kansas City, Missouri. Natural gas service in Kansas City is provided by MGE. As a result of the explosion and subsequent fire, the multi-story apartment building at 101 East 41st Street collapsed.
- 4. There were numerous reported injuries resulting from the incident. Three of the injured required hospitalization; two MGE employees sustained burns and other injuries; and one occupant received a head injury. There were no fatalities.
 - 6. The Staff has initiated a formal investigation into the incident.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to Commission Policy IP-2, the Staff respectfully requests that the Commission establish a docket for the purpose of receiving a Gas Incident Report on this incident.
