Mike, thank you again for the forum. The only thing that I see of issue, as I believe I have stated before, is the firm conviction that REC's should come from MISSOURI sources and not from other states.

The reason is twofold:

1. Jobs creations and revenue stay within the state economy and the state coffers, especially when public money is involved.
2. The commitment to find AFFORDABLE renewable answers is greater -- i.e., the utilities and industries of Missouri are more likely to find affordable technologies faster when they are mandated by law to do so. If they already have affordable out-of-state answers that they are allowed to use as credit, it merely slows down their desire to 'import' that available technology to our state.
