The revised tariffs filed by St. Joseph Light & Power Company, Missouri Power & Light Company and Missouri Edison Company were suspended for 120 days which expires September 12, 1982. The filings were refiled at the request of the Staff to make changes to conform with the Commission Rule and remove language that was unduly restrictive.

The Rule requires the rates to be updated on or before January 15, 1980. Of the generating companies, Union Electric has updated the energy rates from the original filing. This was done from the data required by the June, 1982 PURPA filing requirement. No other rates have been updated from the original filing. The purchasing companies can determine avoided energy costs from the wholesale rate schedule and can develop new tariff rates without sophisticated computer assistance. I anticipate seeking updates for the purchasing companies at the time of general rate cases.

Listed below is a summary of the companies and dates when suspension periods will end. Missouri Utilities' tariff sheets are not now in compliance because the company has not refiled changes as requested by the Staff. It is my opinion the company will comply with the proposed changes, but has not substituted sheets from the original filing.

Only Missouri Utilities' present filed tariff sheets are not recommended to be approved. The Staff recommends approval of the remaining tariffs.
