On November 14, the Commission set a procedural schedule. That schedule requires the parties to file a stipulation of facts no later than December 2, and to file briefs no later than December 23.

The Commission notes that the Missouri Independent Telephone Company Group and the Small Telephone Company Group have asked to intervene. The Commission will order its Staff to state whether it objects to the intervention requests. Also, the Commission notes that Time Warner has already objected to MITG's application to intervene, and will allow Time Warner to respond to STCG's application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall respond to the Missouri Independent Telephone Group's and the Small Telephone Company Group's applications to intervene no later than November 23, 2005.

2. That Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri) LLC d/b/a Time Warner may respond to the Small Telephone Company Group's application to intervene no later than November 23, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on November 16, 2005.
