STATEMENT OF NON-OPPOSITION TO THE
NONUNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND
AGREEMENT AS TO MSBA ISSUES**

COMES NOW the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy (“DE”) and for its Statement of Non-Opposition as to the *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement as to MSBA Issues* states as follows:

1. On July 24, 2019, a number of parties filed a *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement as to MSBA Issues*.
2. Since not all parties were signatories to that agreement, the provisions of 4 CSR 240-2.115 apply. 4 CSR 240-2.115(2)(B) allows a party seven days to object to a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement.
3. DE does not object to the *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement as to MSBA Issues* filed on July 24, 2019.
