Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire submitted tariff sheets on December 11, 2020, to implement a general rate increase for natural gas service. The Commission provided notice of Spire's application and set a deadline of January 12, 2021, for applications to intervene.

On February 10, 2021, Missouri School Boards' Assocation (MSBA) late-filed an application to intervene. MSBA represented that Spire agreed to its late intervention and that all other parties either agreed or had no objection. The Commission will set a time for parties wishing to respond to MSBA's application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to the application to intervene of MSBA shall do so on or before February 18, 2021.
