ORDER CHANGING EVIDENTIARY HEARING TO IN-PERSON

Effective Date: June 9, 2021

On December 11, 2020, Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire filed tariff sheets proposing a general rate increase for natural gas service, and to consolidate, to the extent possible, its two service areas known as Spire East and Spire West.

On February 3, 2021, the Commission issued an *Order Setting Procedural Schedule* setting an evidentiary hearing in this matter, which was ordered to be held via WebEx due to COVID-19. On May 5, 2021, Governor Parson issued a State Workforce Directive which directed all state workers to return to their offices for in-person work no later than May 17, 2021.¹

Accordingly, the Commission will change the scheduled evidentiary hearing to an in-person hearing to be held in the Governor Office Building. The scheduled dates for the evidentiary hearing, July 26, 2021, through August 6, 2021, will remain the same.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The evidentiary hearing scheduled for July 26, 2021, through August 6, 2021, is changed to be held in-person. The hearing will begin at 10:00 a.m. the

first day, and 9:00 a.m. each day thereafter unless otherwise directed by the regulatory law judge.

2. The hearing will be held in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
