ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR

This order grants Kevin R. Zarling leave to appear as counsel for Intervenor Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Embarq ("Embarq") in this matter.

On January 22, 2008, William Watkins filed his Entry of Appearance as counsel on behalf of Embarq in this matter. On the same day, Mr. Watkins filed a verified motion requesting that the Commission grant Kevin R. Zarling, who is not admitted to practice in the State of Missouri, leave to appear and participate in this case as a visiting attorney under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C).

The motion indicates that Mr. Zarling is an active member in good standing of the bar of the State of Iowa, that he is not a member of any law firm, and that he has not been disqualified to appear in any court. Mr. Watkins has designated Mr. Zarling to serve as co-counsel for purposes of this case.

Mr. Watkins has also submitted a January 16, 2008 letter from the Clerk of the Missouri Supreme Court showing Mr. Zarling's compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m) with regard to this case.

The Commission finds that Mr. Watkins has substantially complied with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) and Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m). Accordingly, his motion requesting that Mr. Zarling be granted leave to appear and participate in this case on behalf of Embarras as a visiting attorney is granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. William Watkins' motion requesting that the Commission grant Kevin R. Zarling leave to appear and participate in Case No. LO-2008-0217 as a visiting attorney under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) is granted.

2. This order shall become effective on February 14, 2008.
