**ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On June 26, 2006, the Commission issued its order directing the parties to this case to file a proposed procedural schedule by July 14, 2006.

On June 30, 2006, the Manager of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Public Service Commission filed a Proposed Procedural Schedule. The proposed procedural schedule omitted prefiled testimony.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed procedural schedule and agrees that there is no need for prefiled testimony in this case. Therefore, the Commission will set the hearing as directed below.

In addition, the following procedures shall apply:

(A) The hearing will begin with brief open statements.

(B) Each of the parties shall file a list of its witnesses to appear and the order in which they shall be called.

(C) The Manager of the Commission's Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program will file a list of issues.

(D) Each of the parties shall file a statement of position for each issue.

(E) The Commission's general policy provides for the filing of the transcript within ten days after the hearing. If any party seeks to expedite the filing of the transcript, such request shall be tendered in writing to the Presiding Judge at least five days prior to the date of the hearing.

(F) All parties are required to bring an adequate number of copies of exhibits that they intend to offer into evidence at the hearing. If an exhibit has been previously filed, and served on the other parties, only a copy of the exhibit for the court reporter is necessary. If an exhibit has not been previously been filed, the party offering it should bring one copy for the court reporter, copies for the five Commissioners, the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The procedural schedule is ordered as follows:

Discovery Closed	July 14, 2005
List of Witnesses	July 21, 2005
List of Issues and Statements of Position	July 25, 2005
Evidentiary Hearing	August 8-9, 2006 beginning at 9:00 a.m.

2. The hearing will be held at the Commission's offices in the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, a facility that meets the accessibility standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). 3. This order shall become effective on July 3, 2006.
