## ORDER CANCELING EVIDENTIARY HEARING AND SCHEDULING AN ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION REGARDING STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

An evidentiary hearing on the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program's complaint against Amega Sales, Inc. is scheduled for June 16 and 17, 2008. On May 30, the parties filed a stipulation and agreement that they indicate will resolve their dispute.
